STEM Activity

Activity Category: Academics/Science Technology, Engineering and Mathematics

Focus Categories:

DANCE

Activity Category: Healthy and Active Lifestyle

Focus Categories:

1. Performing Arts – 65%
2. Physical recreation/sports – 25%
3. English as a new language (as most students are non-English speakers) – 10%

NUTRITION

Activity Category: Healthy and Active Lifestyle

Focus Categories: 90%

1. Fitness & Nutrition, 90%
2. STEM Enrichment/Support (Connecting cooking to math/science) – 10%

SNACK TIME

Activity Category: Other

Focus Category:

1. Health & Wellness, Hygiene – 100%
